***Planned Road Closures 09/14 - 09/15***

On September 14<sup>th</sup> through September 15<sup>th</sup> the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce will be hosting “El Grito Fiestas Patrias” at Millenium Park located in the 300 Block of N. Greenwood Drive. The festival location will result in the closure of the 300-400 block of N Greenwood Drive as well as the 100 Block of Locust Drive to all motorized traffic on Saturday September 14<sup>th</sup> starting at about 7am. The roadway will remain closed until the festival’s conclusion on September 15<sup>th</sup> at approximately 9pm.

This event is expected to draw a large attendance and may include many attendees driving vehicles into the area surrounding the festival and parking in public roadways in the Round Lake Park neighborhood. Designated festival parking is located at 220 N. Greenwood Drive (Murphy School) in the south parking lot and the north designated parking area. Follow directions from festival staff. Additional signage will be posted limiting parking to one side of the roadway in residential areas to allow for the safe flow of traffic in and out of the area. Violators will be cited and possibly towed if the location of the vehicle creates a community safety hazard. Attendees are reminded to not park in prohibited parking areas including in front of fire hydrants, driveways and on grass areas.
