Round Lake Park Police announces enforcement results

Round Lake Park, IL – The Round Lake Park Police today announced the results of its enhanced traffic enforcement efforts as part of the Federal Fiscal Year 2025 Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program. These efforts, conducted between Oct. 1, 2024, and Sept. 30, 2025, were aimed at reducing traffic crashes and saving lives.

During the STEP enforcement period, officers issued **154** citations and made **9** arrests. The results include:

- **68** speeding citations.
- **3** occupant restraint citations.
- **19** electronic device use citations.
- **55** other traffic citations.
- **8** traffic arrests.
- **1** criminal arrest.

The goal of this enforcement was to make our roads safer for everyone,” said Chief Burch. “By focusing on the leading causes of crashes – such as speeding, impaired driving, distracted driving and failure to wear seat belts – we aimed to save lives and remind drivers that violating traffic laws will not be tolerated.”

The STEP grant was funded by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of a statewide effort to improve roadway safety and reduce traffic-related fatalities.
